 - in 32(u) – VALUES

- Take bold steps to protect the atmosphere over international waters by pursuing policies and measures for *sustainable aviation and shipping* by
 - Adding in 24(f) “to reducing emissions from aviation and maritime resources” BY ALLOCATING THEIR INTERNATIONAL EMISSIONS.
